- Expected weather in September (during EAFES 2010) : Sunny weather, the most ideal time to visit Korea





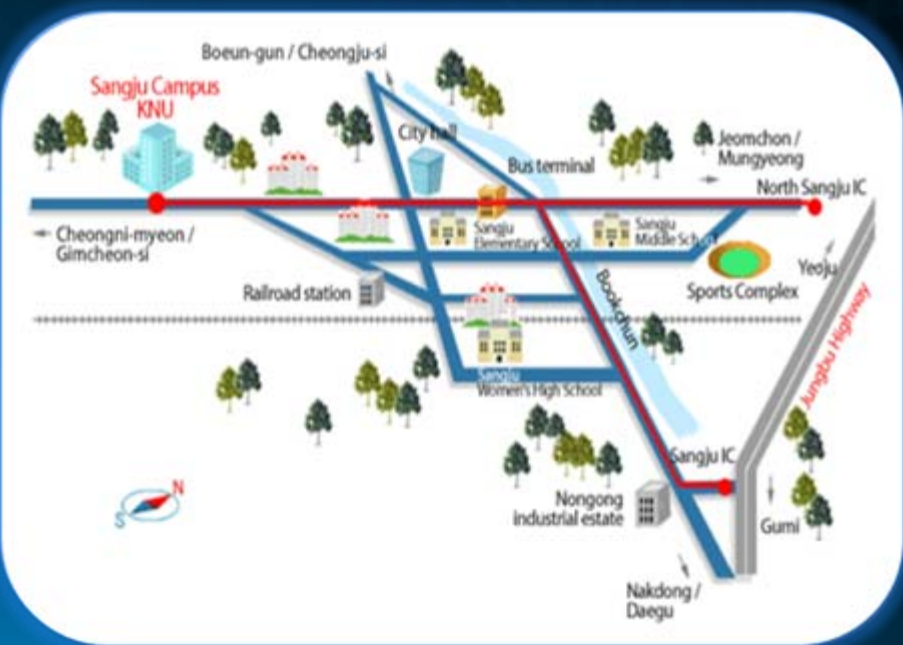

Makgeolli (Korean Rice Wine)

“Makgeolli” is a traditional alcoholic beverage native to Korea. It is made from rice (referred to in English as “Korean rice wine”) which gives it a milky, off-white color, and sweetness. It is made by fermenting a mixture of boiled rice and water, and is about 6.5–7% alcohol by volume.

It has recently started to become more popular, especially with the younger generations and foreigners. “Dongdongju” is a drink very similar to “makgeolli”, and both are commonly imbibed alongside Korean pancakes called “pajeon” or “bindaetteok”.

Additionally, “makgeolli” is used during ancestral rites in Korea.
